We loved the quick and easy vertical block layout by Charlotte O'Leary as a great gift for Dads & Grads in the month of June, or anytime! Simple piecing makes it right for beginners, too! It will be the favorite of the house.



Finished Size Approx 84" x 72"

Cutting Guide:

- 1st Fabric: Cut 2 – 12" X 7"
- 2nd Fabric: Cut 5 – 12" X 7"
AND 1 - 6 1/4" X 7"
- 3rd Fabric: Cut 5 – 12" X 7"
- 4th Fabric: Cut 3 – 12" X 7"
- 5th Fabric: Cut 4 – 12" X 7"
- 6th Fabric: Cut 2 – 12" X 7"
- 7th Fabric: Cut 27 – 2" X 2"
AND 4 - 1 1/2" strips (1st border)
- 8th Fabric: Cut 8 - 2" strips (3rd border)
AND 18 – 10 3/4" X 2" (for rows 1-3-5)
AND 9 – 12 3/4" X 2" (rows 2-4-6)
AND 6 – 13 1/4" X 2" (rows 2-4-6)
- 9th Fabric: Cut 1 – 12" X 7"
AND 2 – 6 1/4" X 7"
- 10th Fabric: Cut 2 – 12" X 7"
- 11th Fabric: Cut 2 – 12" X 7"
- 12th Fabric: Cut 4 – 12" X 7"
- 13th Fabric: Cut 2 – 12" X 7"
- 14th Fabric: Cut 2 – 12" X 7"
AND 1 – 6 1/4" X 7"
- 15th Fabric: Cut 8 – 5 1/2" strips (4th border)
AND 2 – 12" X 7"
- 16th Fabric: Cut 1 – 12" X 7"
AND 1 – 6 1/4" X 7"
- 17th Fabric: Cut 1 – 12" X 7" & 1 – 6 1/4" X 7"
- 18th Fabric: Cut 8 – 1 1/2" strips (2nd border)
AND 1 – 12" X 7"

The estimated yardage for this fabric assumes that long pieces ARE pieced.

Indicates border fabrics and sashing fabric (37 patches) and sashing squares (31 patches)

Yardages for Binding and Backing are NOT included here

Construction:

Following the quilt layout, sew end to end the 12" X 7" blocks in the order shown to construct the 1st row.

2nd Row starts and ends with a 6 1/4" X 7" block. Sew as shown in layout.

Rows 1, 3, 5, & 7 are constructed with all 12" X 7" blocks

Rows 2, 4, 6, are constructed starting and ending with a 6 1/4" X 7" half blocks. *Follow the layout carefully.*

Sashing:

Column 1,3,5 sew end to end same as for blocks a 2" X 10 3/4" strip and a 2" square then another 2" X 10 3/4" strip as in the layout. (6 strips 5 square blocks in each column)

Column 2,4,6 sew end to end same as before a 2" X 13 1/4" strip and a 2" square then a 2" X 12 3/4" strip with a 2" square, etc (using 3 - 12 3/4" strips) finishing with a 13 1/4" strip.

Borders:

1st border is a 1 1/2" cut strip to make a 1" border. Strips will have to be pieced. The preferred method to piece a border is to sew the ends together with a diagonal seam.

2nd border is also a 1 1/2" cut strip to make a 1" border.

3rd border is a 2" cut strip to make a 1 1/2" border.

4th border is a 5 1/2" cut strip to make a 5" border.
Mitered corners will look like the sample corner below.

Finishing:

Choose your favorite Nottingham Village prints for the backing and binding. (Note that these are not included in the yardage list)

Sandwich the top, batting and backing ,and quilt in the manner you wish. Bind using a 2 1/2" binding. This quilt is easily adaptable to other finished sizes by adding rows or blocks and sashing, or increasing the block size.
